

James Kreppner Award Program Letter of Intent

Overview

Applicants are advised to review the Canadian Blood Services James Kreppner Award Program Guidelines.

The completed LOI must be delivered to Canadian Blood Services by 11:59 PM Oct. 28, 2022 (Pacific Time).

Instructions

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the LOI is delivered by the deadline. No late submissions will be accepted.

The LOI must be delivered as a PDF document on institutional letterhead **by email to** <u>centreforinnovation@blood.ca</u>.

The LOI must not exceed two (2) pages in length, with a font size no smaller than 11 point. Appendices to the LOI are not permitted.

The LOI must include the following:

- First and last name of Applicant, position title and name of academic institution. In addition, applicants who are health sciences researchers must demonstrate that their experience and/ or research team composition is appropriate to conduct a legal and/or bioethics research project.
- Project Title
- Project summary (clearly addressing <u>relevance</u> and <u>merit/feasibility</u> criteria as outlined in the JKA program guidelines)
- Confirmation that the proposed budget will not exceed \$50,000
- Signature of the Applicant on behalf of the project team
